Proposed New Deacons

Last Sunday, the Elders presented 10 men to the congregation that will be installed next Sunday as Deacons over a variety of ministries; asking that we consider these men, their families, their service to God and their reputation in the larger community.

If anyone has a reason scripturally why these men should be disqualified as deacons, they are to go to them individually as the scripture states in Matthew 18:15-17.

If you are not satisfied after talking with them, then submit your objections to the elders in writing with your signature attached.
