Cups containing the bread and the juice shared during this time are available in the lobby. For baptized believers, this is a moment for reflection & remembrance.

We also take up a weekly offering to help advance God's Kingdom both locally and abroad. As a guest, you are not expected to make an offering. Offerings are made by our members as part of their commitment to God and the church.
