To count as 2024 charitable contributions the donation must be **PHYSICALLY** received in the year 2024. The **ONLY** exception to this rule, is donations that are mailed through the United States Postal Service, donations are considered **PHYSICALLY** received on the date they are **POSTMARKED**, not the date they are delivered.

Examples:

J writes a check for 12/29/24 and drops it in giving box on 12/29/24 = 2024 Contribution.

J writes a check for 12/29/24 and it is **POSTMARKED** 12/26/24 but not received until 1/2/25 = 2024 Contribution.

Contribution reports for tax purposes will be mailed by 1/20/2025.
